
SENIOR PATTERN CONTEST October 12-13, 2013

<u>Airplane</u> – Senior Pattern competition is done with an RC airplane designed and flown before 1976. The engine can be a maximum .65 two stroke or .95 four stroke. Pilots can be any age. First time SPA event entrants can fly any airplane that has a qualifying engine.

<u>Classes</u> – Novice-B, Novice, Sportsman, Advanced and Expert. Go to <u>seniorpattern.com</u> for complete rules, qualifying aircraft and pattern sequences. Awards for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} in each event. Classes may be combined if there are fewer than three contestants per class.

AMA membership is required for pilots in all classes.
